

Year 2 Homework challenge — Autumn Term 2 2023



Each week your child can choose any **one** of the following challenges to complete and remember you don't need to write every piece. Any evidence is fine — writing, photos, pictures, models, videos (upload to Purple Mash) etc. **They can be done in any order. In addition, Maths will be set on MyMaths and Spellings/Phonics on Purple Mash. We expect EVERY child to do their homework EVERY week.** Please feel free to help your child with their homework, but don't do it for them! Homework is due on **Thursdays** either in **homework books** or uploaded to **Purple Mash**. Thank you for your support!

1. **Science** ~ Make a minibeast model/drawing! It could be an animal that we have found in the school grounds (e.g. a woodlouse, worm, snail, centipede, spider) or a type of beetle, butterfly, fly etc. You **HAVE** to be scientists and your model **MUST** be scientifically accurate. Label the parts of the minibeast and include some interesting facts.

2. **English** ~ Can you write/draw a new Superworm adventure? Re read the story online ~ there's a good version on YouTube (Bedtime Stories UK) What might happen next between Superworm and Lizard Wizard? Use the storyboard in your Homework Book.

3. **Computing:** Practise using different photographic filters/effects on a phone/ipad or P.C. What is your favourite effect and why? Upload your photo to Purple Mash.

8. **RE** ~ This term, we are thinking about looking after the Earth and what we treasure. Write and draw about what you treasure about the natural world.

5. **Phonics** ~ Complete the Phase 3/5 workbook (depending on your phonic phase). You don't have to do it all at once, you can work through across the term.
