Welcome to a new half term at school! We hope you have had good half term holiday! As with all the other things your child will be learning in school, we want to share with you what we will be doing in Religious Education.

During this 2nd half of the Summer Term the children will be learning about **People of Faith.**

They will have opportunities to **learn about** and explain that the Bible came together over a period of more than a thousand years and contains sacred texts from Judaism, the four Gospels, and other early writings of the Church.; understand that the Church teaches that Sacred Scripture is the inspired Word of God and the Church helps Catholics read and understand the Bible; understand that the Bible is translated from different languages into many languages; recognise that the Tanakh uses different names for God that reveal aspects of his nature; use specialist vocabulary to describe some Jewish beliefs expressed in the Shema prayer.

They will have opportunities to **respond to learning** and reflect on the books that matter to them in their life; talk to others about their sacred texts and why they matter; think and talk about ways of showing respect for sacred texts.

Ways to help at home...

Talk with your child about what they have been learning about in school.

Ask your child about who is in their community and the different faiths they experience.

Ask your child how they care for others and show them how you care for and about them.

Talk to your child about how they can be a good neighbour.

Use bedtime prayers as a time to thank God for all the wonderful things He has given us.
