Welcome to a new half term at school! We hope you have had good half term holiday! As with all the other things your child will be learning in school, we want to share with you what we will be doing in Religious Education.

During this 2nd half of the Summer Term the children will be learning about **People of Faith.**

They will have opportunities to learn about and explain the meaning of 'the common good' and the principles of Catholic Social Teaching; describe some ways Christians work together with people of different worldviews to promote the common good; use the term 'worldviews' and understand its meaning; recognise links and simple connections between some Dharmic beliefs, practices, and way of life making links between them. They will have opportunities to talk & think about creatively & critically and reflect on the statement 'Everyone should be concerned to create and support institutions that improve the conditions of human life' and consider how this challenges people to change; consider the term 'common good', discuss why charities with different worldviews work to promote the same goals; explore some examples of creative expressions of faith from a Dharmic pathway; listen to the stories and experiences of those who follow a Dharmic pathway in their class and the wider community and ask questions about their laws, beliefs, worship, or life.
